DIRECTIONS

Gila, New Mexico, is located off of U.S. Route 180 about 30 miles northwest of Silver City and 30 miles southeast of Glenwood, in Southwestern New Mexico. We are 4 miles from the village of Gila.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

1. Between March 11 and November 3, 2012, ***NEW MEXICO TIME IS 1 HOUR LATER THAN ARIZONA TIME!***
2. **Check-in is between 3-6 PM NEW MEXICO TIME.** Please phone ***BEFORE 6 PM*** if you will be delayed. From ***cell phone***: 575-535-4455; from ***land line*** 877-923-4827.
3. Occasionally the southern part of Rt. 211 to Gila may be closed due to Bear Creek flooding. If you are coming from Silver City and encounter a "Detour" or "Road Closed 3-1/2 mi Ahead" sign, continue on Rt. 180 for another 5 miles to Cliff (N 32°57.804' W 108°36.801'). Turn right onto Rt. 211 and follow the directions from Albuquerque on reverse. ***Do NOT attempt to cross Bear Creek if it is running across the road!***

FROM SILVER CITY (ALLOW 40 MINUTES) AND SOUTH OF GILA:

Follow Rt. 180 west thru Silver City (last chance for supermarket, beer/wine) (note: Rt. 180 makes a sharp right at the Do-It Center); continue 25 miles, then turn right onto Rt. 211 (***see #3 above***). In about 4 miles you will reach the village of Gila. Continue straight, past the Valley Market, onto Rt. 153 (N 32°58.873' W 108°34.652'). Go about 200 yards and turn right onto Hooker Loop, a gravel road (road sign may be missing; watch for turquoise Casitas sign on fence post).

DO NOT CROSS BEAR CREEK if it is running across Rt. 211! See #3 above for alternate route.

******Follow Hooker Loop about 4 miles; turn right at Double E Ranch Road (N 32°58.455' W 108°31.987'). After a half mile turn right at Casita Flats Rd (N 32°58.189' W 108°31.666'). Continue a half-mile more and you will reach Casitas de Gila. (Please drive carefully and slowly here as the road is only one lane wide and there can be two-way traffic.) Come to the office.

— **MORE DIRECTIONS ON OTHER SIDE** —

FROM ALBUQUERQUE (ALLOW 5 HOURS) AND NORTH OF GILA:

Exit I-25 at Socorro (last chance for supermarket, beer/wine). Follow Rt. 60 to Datil, then turn left onto Rt. 12. Follow Rt. 12 to Rt. 180 after Reserve (note that Rt. 12 makes a sharp right turn in Reserve; if you miss it, you will drive for miles into the Gila Forest before you realize your mistake). Turn left onto Rt. 180 and continue until you reach Rt. 211 at Cliff (N 32°57.804' W 108°36.801'). Turn left onto Rt. 211. Follow Rt. 211 until you reach the village of Gila, then bear left onto Rt. 153 (N 32°58.873' W 108°34.652'). Go about 200 yards and turn right onto Hooker Loop, a gravel road. Continue by following the directions on reverse from **.

Alternate (5-1/2 hrs): I-25 south to Rt. 152 to Rt. 180 to Silver City. This is NOT a shorter route to Casitas de Gila, unless you plan on stopping in Silver City first. Also, winter guests should be aware that Rt. 152 is mountainous and is **not plowed** on winter weekends.

From TUCSON (allow 3-3/4 hours):

Take I-10 east to Lordsburg, NM. Take Rt. 90 north to Silver City and follow Silver City directions.

From PHOENIX (allow 5 hours):

Take I-10 east to Lordsburg, NM. Take Rt. 90 north to Silver City and follow Silver City directions.

From EL PASO AIRPORT (allow 3-1/2 hours):

Take I-10 west to Deming, NM. Take Rt. 180 west to Silver City and follow Silver City directions.

From LAS CRUCES (allow 2-1/2 hours):

Take I-10 west to Deming, NM. Take Rt. 180 west to Silver City and follow Silver City directions.

ABOUT PROVIONING ...

There is a **GAS STATION** on Rt. 180 in Cliff; open daily till 6:30 PM.

There is an Albertson's Supermarket on Rt. 180 in Silver City; open daily till 11 PM. There's a food co-op in Silver City on Bullard Street; open Mon-Sat till 7 PM.

We have available restaurant-quality **chicken breasts** (frozen, 8 oz. ea, boneless/skinless, \$3 each) and **wrangler steaks** (frozen, 6 oz. ea, \$5 each). Call ahead and we can defrost them for your arrival. Each Casita has a full kitchen and bbq grill with charcoal and starter.

RESTAURANTS:

At the present time there is no restaurant open for dinner in the Gila/Cliff area. You can eat in Deming (Si Señor is great; closes at 3 PM on Sundays), Silver City, Glenwood (Blue Front Cafe or Mario's), or Reserve, depending on which town you pass through.
